Points of information:

The tour will begin at Brookwood Point at 6000 State Highway 80, West Lake Road, Cooperstown. It's about 7 minutes from downtown Cooperstown, past the Farmer's Museum, and is clearly marked with a white sign. Please park in the big grassy upper lot by the little kiosk.

If you haven't been before, this is an amazing site with picnic areas, gardens, a composting toilet, fishing, birding, wetland trail, ADA accessible trail, and public access paddling. As a special perk for The WKC Garden Tour, Brookwood will open its Garden House for us.

This is a self-guided tour. You will receive directions to the rest of the properties upon check-in. If you know of other friends or family who may wish to join you, feel free to share this email with them and they can register and pay at the first garden.
